SB 1272 requires that an applicant obtain a concealed weapon permit from the sheriff or a chief of police within the county of his residence.

The Attorney General and Legislative Counsel have no constitutional or legal objections to approval.

The bill was sponsored by the Attorney General. The bill is intended to stop "shopping" for permits throughout the State.

The Peace Officers' and District Attorneys' Association request approval.

Herb Ellingwood recommends approval.

Letters have been received requesting that the bill be vetoed.

Senator Moscone, the author, requests approval.
